The completed form with supporting documentation shall be submitted to CAA-Norway 14 days prior to the planned start of operations. Scheduled operators may present alternate means of documentation, in agreement with the CAA-N. After reviewing the compliance documentation and finding it adequate, CAA-N will issue a letter of compliance to the operator. A copy of this letter needs to be carried on board, to document fulfillment of the requirements upon request from local airport authorities or representatives from CAA-N.</i></p>
